

School Board Election. The annual School Board Election will be held on November 2, 2010. Voters will fill two open positions on the board; both positions are four year terms.

Candidates for the November 2, 2010 election must be a U.S. citizen at least 18 years old, a registered voter, state of Michigan resident for at least 30 days and a resident in the Lakeville Community School District at least 30 days before the election.

Candidates for the November 2, 2010 election may pick up and file an Affidavit of Identity and a nominating petition with the Genesee County Clerk's office by 4:00 p.m. on Tuesday, August 10, 2010. A \$100.00 nonrefundable fee must be filed in lieu of a petition.

The withdrawal deadline for board candidates is Friday, August 13, 2010, 4:00 PM.

Absentee ballots will be available by Wednesday, October 13, 2010 at your local township office (your voting location).

Write-in candidates must file by 4:00 PM, Friday, October 22, 2010.
