SCHOOL BOND PROPOSAL

On February 28, 2012 LakeVille Community School District voters will be asked to approve a 15 year Bond Proposal which raises 11.69 million dollars for facility and site improvements. **You will be asked to vote on two separate proposals that will have an immediate impact on improving opportunities for students by providing safe, secure and stimulating educational environments.**

WHAT IS THE GOAL?

- Equity – Improve the teaching and learning environment and facilities for **ALL** LakeVille Community School District students
- Improve safety and security for students, staff and community members
- Increase opportunities for community programming – ex: community theatre, technology labs available for community
- Meet 21st century college and career readiness opportunities due to updated technology infrastructure and tools
- Provide ongoing cost savings due to energy project upgrades lowering District operating costs

FEATURES OF THE 2012 BOND

PROPOSAL 1: Critical for Learning / Improving current facilities - \$7,580,000 (.9 mills). The interest cost of this proposal is offset by \$5,000,000 of Qualified Zone Academy Bond Loans we were awarded.

Educational Facilities

- Upgrade interior wall finishes in corridors at Otisville, Columbiaville Annex, High School
- Renovate existing High School media center Renovate interior of Columbiaville Annex
- Renovate Men's and Women's Restrooms in the High School, Alternative High School and Middle School
- Renovate toilet rooms in Administrative Building to be ADA compliant

- Replace roofs at Otter Lake Elementary, High School Annex and Columbiaville Elementary Annex

Safety

- Provide new electronic surveillance system at interior and exterior of all school buildings and bus garage.
- Construct enclosed corridor to connect Columbiaville annex and High School Annex to main building
- Provide a keyless security entry system at all school buildings
- Remove and replace poor asphalt paving in parking lots and drives and replace damaged sidewalk areas as needed.

Energy Upgrades

- Replace unit ventilators in classrooms and library at the High School and Columbiaville Annex and install new temperature controls for energy management at all buildings where needed
- Replace exterior hollow metal doors and frames with new aluminum FRP doors at Otisville, Columbiaville, High School and Administration Building and replace exterior windows in Columbiaville Elementary Annex and the Administrative Building
- Replace walk in freezer in High School, Middle School, Columbiaville Elementary
- Replace air handling unit at Alternative High School, Columbiaville Gym
- Electrical and lighting upgrades all buildings including adding lighting occupancy sensors in areas not currently covered in all school buildings
- Replace domestic water and hot water heating and piping in tunnels

Technology

- Install new Alternative Energy SmartLab in Middle School
- Renovate existing space in the High School Annex for new computer, technology and art rooms and for a new corridor art gallery
- Provide and install 120 new computers and 12 printers
- Replace District telephone System

Athletics

- Replace **current** wood stadium seating, footboards, risers, railing and fencing with new aluminum seats. Create new stadium entry gates, signage, ticket booth and public plaza.
- Replace the current track with a **six** lane track
- Provide additional drainage at perimeter of football field
- Reorganize area around bleachers and concessions to improve traffic flow, security and handicapped accessibility
- Provide asphalt paved access path from the west parking lot at the high school to the varsity baseball and softball diamonds to improve safety and handicapped accessibility
- Replace lockers in Boys Team Room

Furnishings and Equipment

- New Media Center Furniture
- Purchase three new buses

PROPOSAL 2: Quality of Life - \$4,110,000 (.65 mills)

- Construct a new 500 seat auditorium, toilet rooms
- Add 35 space parking lot

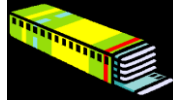
Proposal 1 + Proposal 2 = \$77.50 yearly tax increase

PROPOSAL 1: The tax increase for approving proposal 1 is determined by multiplying the taxable value by .0009.

WHAT IS THE TAX IMPACT FOR APPROVING PROPOSAL 2? The tax increase for approving proposal 2 is determined by multiplying the taxable value by .00065.

VOTER APPROVAL OF BOTH PROPOSALS = 1.55 MILLS
