Hall of Honor

Purpose: The purpose of the District Hall of Honor is to acknowledge alumni and other individuals associated with Lakeville Community Schools for their achievements and contributions to society. Recognizing the Lakeville traditions of excellence and service to the community and society demonstrated by Hall of Honor inductees will serve as an inspiration to all current and future Falcons as we stand on the shoulders of those who came before.

Eligibility:

1. Nominees must meet one or more of the following three:
 - a. Graduate of Lakeville Community Schools with a least ten (10) years having passed since graduation
 - b. Employee or former employee of the Lakeville Community School District
 - c. Community member who has provided sustained contributions to Lakeville Community Schools or the larger community and served as a major influence in the lives of our students and staff in some manner

*Posthumous nominations will be accepted.
2. All nominees must have made, in the opinion of the selection committee, an important contribution to Lakeville Community Schools, the Lakeville community, or to society in general.
3. Candidate criteria:
 - a. Demonstrated positive leadership and service or contributions to the Lakeville community or to society.
 - b. Recognized as a respected leader in his/her profession or avocation. Has demonstrated unique talents and/or career accomplishments.
 - c. Exceptional achievements in the cultural, visual, performing arts and/or for contributions to the promotion of cultural activities on a local, state or national level.
 - d. Outstanding achievements in the field of athletics at the college or professional level, or for contributions to the promotion of athletic activities on a local, state or national level.
 - e. Elected or appointed to a prominent position of great responsibility used to contribute positively to society.
 - f. Attained a position of great responsibility in the armed forces or has been recognized for valor under combat conditions.
 - g. The selection committee may consider nominations that are of a unique nature and do not readily fit the above examples of criteria; however a nominee's accomplishment and/or contribution must be significant and positive.

Nomination Procedure:

1. Nominations can be made by any individual who has sufficient knowledge of the nominee and the reason for the nominee's submission.
2. All nominations must include a LakeVille Hall of Honor nomination form with an attached narrative describing in full the reason(s) the nominee deserves consideration.
3. Nominations will be accepted annually until June 30. All nominations should be delivered or mailed to: LakeVille Community Schools, 11107 Washburn Rd., Otisville, MI 48463, and Attention: Hall of Honor.
4. After all nominations have been received, the selection committee will meet and select the candidates to be inducted each year into the LakeVille Community Schools Hall of Honor by August 1.

Selection Committee: The Superintendent is responsible for maintaining a selection committee. The committee will include members representing the LakeVille community, faculty, district administration and the Board of Education. The current superintendent and one representative from the school board shall be members of the committee.

Limitation on Number of Inductees: The selection committee reserves the right to limit the number of inductees. The committee shall at all times maintain high standards for selection into the Hall of Honor by scrutinizing all nominees and only voting affirmative on those that represent the standards of excellence outlined in this document.

Recognition of Inductees:

1. Individuals selected by the committee will be notified by the district superintendent or other administrative staff.
2. Each year, on the Thursday of Homecoming weekend, the district will host an induction ceremony. Selected nominee(s) will be recognized and inducted into the LakeVille Community Schools Hall of Honor at the social event.
3. Pictures will be permanently mounted in the lobby of the gymnasium at LakeVille Memorial High School of each person inducted in the Hall of Honor. The picture will include a plaque with the name of the individual, the specific accomplishment for which he/she has been inducted in the Hall of Honor, and the year of induction. Each inductee will also have his/her photograph and a short biography displayed on the monitor located in the lobby of the gymnasium.
