Re: Summer School Credit Recovery Classes

Lakeville High School's summer school credit recovery program is being offered once again this year! Students can take up to two classes. Summer school will run from July 6, 2020 – July 31, 2020. **Payment for classes must be received by June 30<sup>th</sup> in order to be registered for classes.** Please mail payment and the registration form to the address noted on this letter. Also include: To the Attention of Summer School in the address/envelope. **The cost per class is \$50.00; students who qualify for reduced/free lunch will have a reduced cost of \$20.00 per class. Students can take up to two courses during the four week summer school period. Students who complete a course with a passing grade will receive a 50% refund for each class taken. Refunds will be processed within two weeks after the end of summer school. Again, all payments and registration forms must be received by the high school by June 30<sup>th</sup>.**

Students will be able to access their coursework at <https://www.edgenuity.com/login/>. Students' usernames and passwords will be emailed to the address listed on the registration form by 8:00 pm on July 5<sup>th</sup>. Weekly progress reports will also be sent directly to this email as well. Wifi access is needed to access Edgenuity. Edgenuity can be utilized via android devices, smartphones, as well as any type of computer or laptop.

Grades for coursework taken and completed will be processed no later than the end of the work day on August 7<sup>th</sup>. Families will receive an email with verification of the grade processed. Again, the email used for this notification will be the email included on the registration form.
